
Merge Lists





Recipe Overview



This is a recipe for merging two lists by matching on a common attribute

This is ideal for:

- Merging two large lists
- Appending one large primary list with data from a reference / look-up list
- Merging data from two different sources



Sample Data: Inputs






Data Source 1 Name + ID

> > Matching attribute: email




Attributes to append from #2 to #1






To add a new mapping between the two data sources



To add a new attribute to the primary data source




To download output data, click on the DOWNLOAD button on the Search screen


Want to do more? Try the following on your own:
