Recipe Overview

This is a recipe to import data from Pardot


- Obtain your API User Key
- Create a Pardot Data Source
- Import Pardot Data

You will need the following:

- Pardot account and credentials

Create a Pardot Data Source



In the "Data" dropdown list, click on "Data Sources" to go to the Data Source screen.

Click on "Add Data Source" to create a new data source .

Pick "Salesforce Pardot" and click on "Authenticate" to enter Pardot connection details.

Pick which entity, Prospect or Prospect Account, to import from Pardot for this data source.

Enter your Pardot credentials and for "User Key", enter the API User Key obtained earlier. Test the authentication is fine and save.

Verify Sample Data

Verify that sample data from your Pardot environment is showing without issues.




Choose the attributes to import. It is best to import only the attributes that you need for processing. When done, click on "Finish" at the bottom of the page.

Recommendations


- Import only the attributes that you need from Pardot to minimize data volume

Want to do more? Try the following on your own:

- Import the Pardot Prospect Accounts from your Pardot environment
- Clean and normalize the Pardot data. For example: normalize state and country names, clean up company names
- Create a Pardot Prospect or Prospect Account data target to push data back into your Pardot environment
